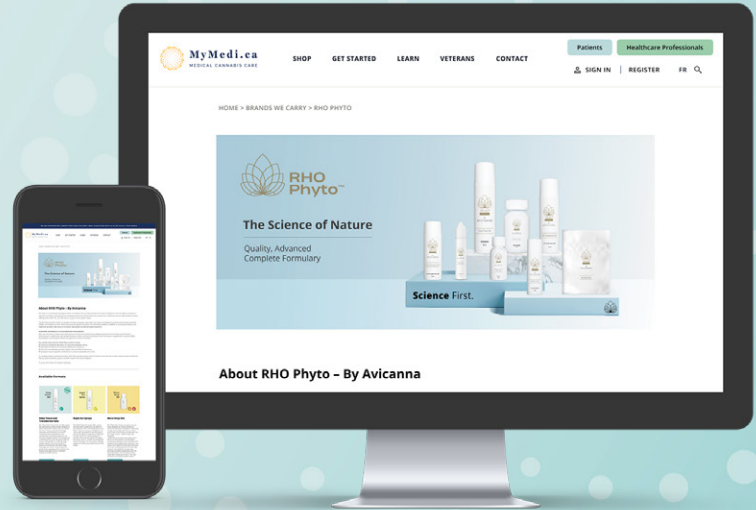

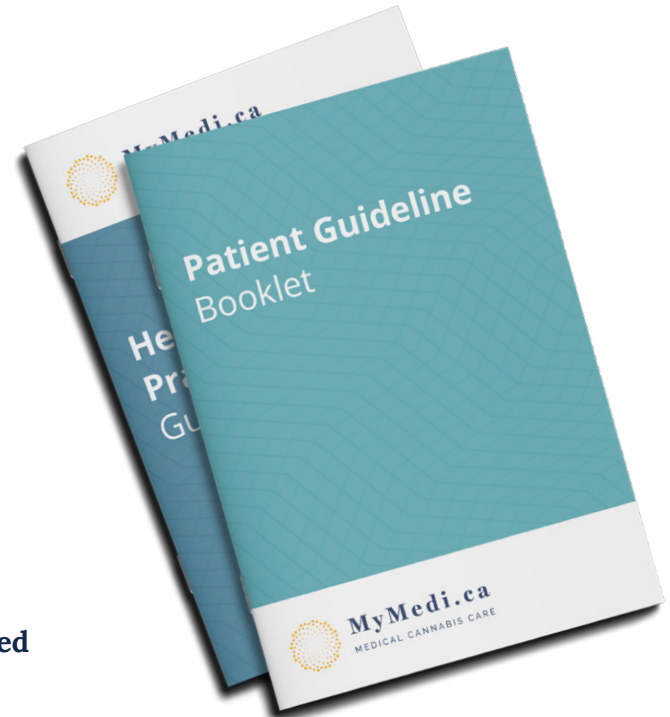

Trunerox 10% CBD

- First indication specific pharmaceutical product with marketing authorization
- Approved by INVIMA (Colombia) for Adjunctive Treatment of Seizures Associated with Lennox Gastaut Syndrome (LGS) and Dravet Syndrome (DS)
- 10% CBD proprietary formulation manufactured under GMP standards and utilizing the company's purified API



Osteoarthritis Pain | Phase II Clinical Program

A randomized, placebo-controlled clinical trial evaluating oral cannabinoid-based therapies



Study Overview:

- Phase II pilot clinical trial
- Oral cannabinoid formulations (CBD & THC capsules)
- Hip and knee osteoarthritis patients
- Funded by CIHR grant, sponsored by Avicanna



Clinical Design:

- Randomized, placebo-controlled
- 3-arm parallel group study
- Evaluating pain interference outcomes
- Led by Dr. Hance Clarke

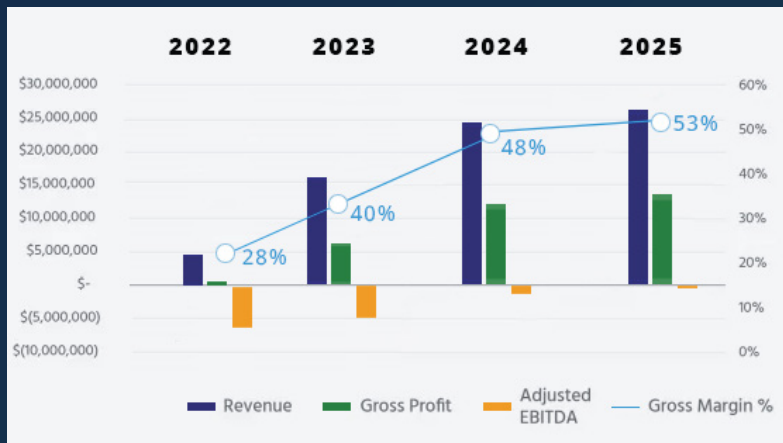

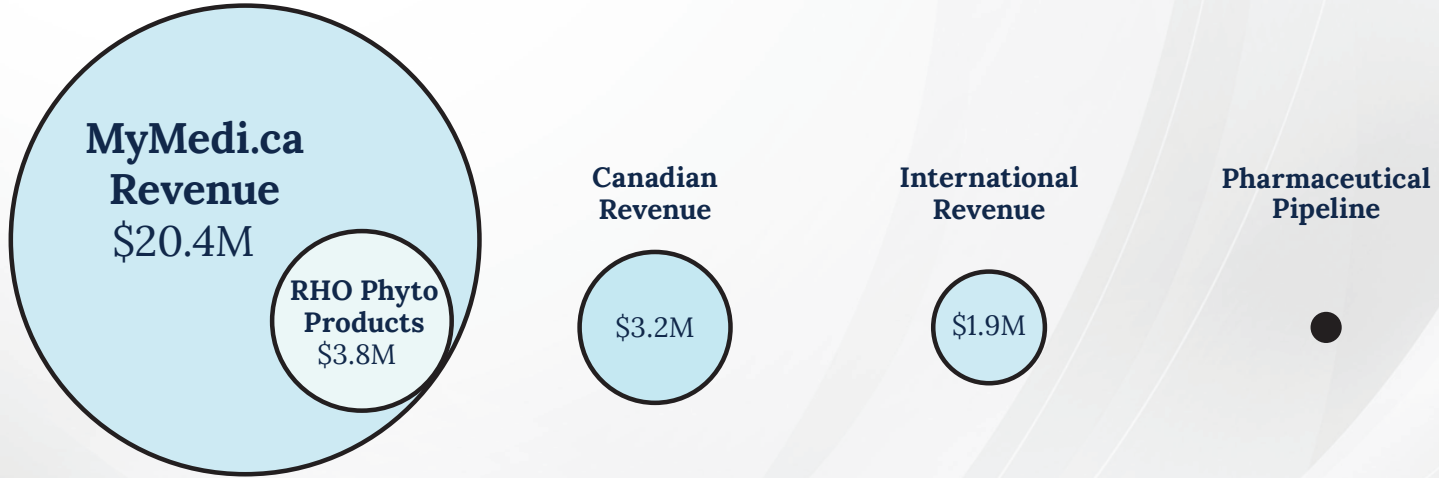
